Shakespeare's *Much Ado About Nothing* and the World Premiere of Michael Hollinger's *The Virgin Queen Entertains Her Fool* Open Saturday

SPRING GREEN, WIS: American Players Theatre (APT) This Saturday marks the opening of two additional plays in APT's illustrious 45th Anniversary Season. In the 1,075-seat Hill Theatre, William Shakespeare's beloved comedy about sparring will-they-won't-they lovers, *Much Ado About Nothing*, will hold its opening night this Saturday, June 22 at 8:00 PM. Directed by Robert Ramirez (*The River Bride*, 2022), and featuring Jessica Ko as Beatrice and Core Company Actor Marcus Truschinski as Benedick, this witty hit will play through September 29.

In his director's notes, **Ramirez** said of the play "I love this play. I love its unabashed romanticism, its witty wordplay and outright physical humor. I even love its sometimes-seeming implausibility. I also believe in its inherent messages; those of forgiveness, redemption, and most importantly, love. Love has the power to transform people and to equip them with the strength they need to endure whatever trials they face. And, ultimately, to forgive those responsible for our pain."

In the 201-seat Touchstone Theatre, APT welcomes the world-premiere of Michael Hollinger's comi-tragedy *The Virgin Queen Entertains Her Fool* at 2:00 PM on June 22. Directed by award-winning playwright and director Aaron Posner (Playwright, *Anton's Shorts*, 2023; Director, *The Rivals*, 2022), and featuring Tracy Michelle Arnold, Jim DeVita, Josh Krause and Nancy Rodríguez, this play has sold out many performances, and APT has added five performances to keep up with demand. Best availability is on Wednesday, September 11 and September 12 at 7:30 PM.

Hollinger said in his playwright's note, "One thing I noticed was how many queens have shown up in our popular culture in recent years: multiple portraits of both Elizabeths, Queen Anne in The Favourite, the musical Six and the badass queens in Game of Thrones. (I don't include the throng of Disney princesses, as these are young enough to still believe they "can have it all," and haven't yet had to deal with the actual burdens of statecraft.) When I started, we had also just gone through the 2016 Presidential campaign – the first time a major U.S. party had nominated a female candidate. So I guess I was primed to work on a play exploring, among other things, the particular trials and sacrifices of women in power."

APT is a professional repertory theater devoted to the great and future classics. It was founded in 1979 and continues to be one of the most popular outdoor classical theaters in the nation.

The Theatre is located in Spring Green, Wis., on 110 acres of hilly woods and meadows above the Wisconsin River. The outdoor amphitheater is built within a natural hollow atop an oakwooded hill. Under the dome of sky, 1,075 comfortably cushioned seats encircle three sides of the stage. In 2009, APT opened the 201-seat indoor Touchstone Theatre, offering a different type of play and experience.
