A gripping and electric story, *The Brothers Size* features Rasell Holt, Derrick Moore, Nathan Barlow, and Jamaque Newberry in this contemporary drama originally slated for the 2020 season.

Last seen at APT in 2013, *Hamlet* returns to the Hill Theatre. This iconic play continues to connect with audiences through its mix of Shakespeare's poetic language and the story's relevancy for our, and every, era. Starring Core Company member Nate Burger in the titular role, this starlit ensemble features Kelsey Brennan, David Daniel, Alys Dickerson, Jamal James, , Chiké Johnson, Colleen Madden, and Triney Sandoval.

Artistic Director Brenda DeVita said of *The Brothers Size*, "McCraney uses his exquisite, poetic style to carve out the relationship between these three men, and their love for one another, and their frustration with one another, and their hopes for the future, which include just holding onto their livelihoods and their freedom. It's a gorgeous, powerful, heartbreaking play; And the amazing Gavin Lawrence – actor, and playwright, and the most thoughtful human I know – is making his directorial debut with this play. He's been thinking about this production for more than two years now, since it was first slated to be on stage in 2020. It's going to be one of those plays you don't want to miss."

DeVita continued, "Hamlet is one of those plays that we can see again and again, each time with new eyes and a new perspective. The heat of youth, or the clarity of experience – every subsequent production points us, as audience members, towards something completely novel. And at the same time, it's a universal story. We are incredibly fortunate to have this cast on board: Nate Burger, who is playing Hamlet, and who invests his whole heart in every role he plays. And Kelsey Brennan, who is like his best friend, playing his best friend, Horatio. And Alys Dickerson as Ophelia and Jamal James as Laertes, also great friends, playing brother and sister, with Chiké Johnson as Polonius, their father. And Colleen Madden and Triney Sandoval as Gertrude and Claudius. It's all the things: funny, and touching, and scary, and dangerous. And just deeply, deeply human. That's why we see it."
